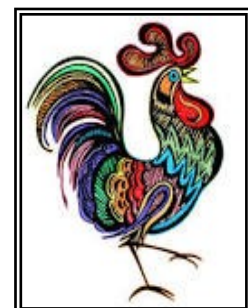
The next scheduled secretariat meeting will take place January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at Red Hill Lutheran starting at 7pm. in the church library.
